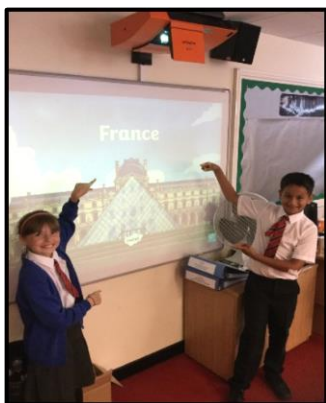
### Diary Dates
