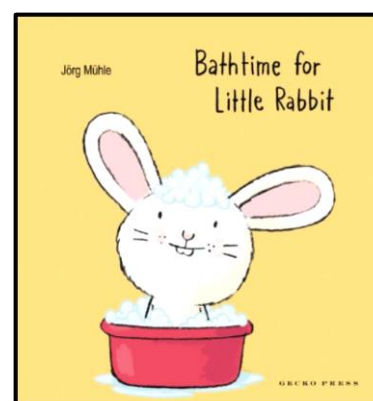
This week's recommended read is for children aged 0 - 3...
