New menu has been sent home today. This starts on Monday 12th November 2018. Please check book bags!

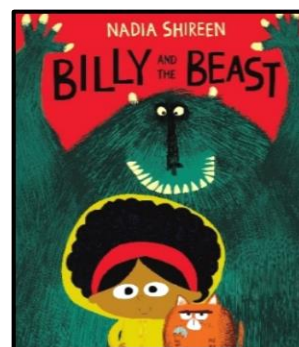
Reading Corner
