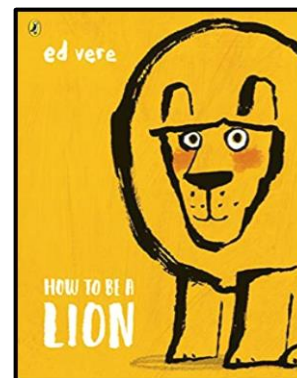
How to Be a Lion
